To ensure that transitions are supported to assist pupils in managing change

<ul> <li>Transition mentor, student manger and SEN team work closely with our feeder primary schools to prepare children for change.</li> <li>School works closely in contact with parents and children to ease children into change</li> <li>Staff give pupils advance warning that learning is going to move onto the next phase.</li> <li>Teachers give pupils thinking time ahead of cold calling.</li> </ul>	schoolenquiries@thecedarsacademy.org.uk  Enhanced transition for pupils with SEN needs, attendance concerns, vulnerable students, PP, pupils highlighted by primary schools who would struggle with transition and need more time on site  Nurture group run 2 x weekly supporting students who are struggling with transition  Transition lead attached to year 7 until Christmas to support transition from 6-7.  Additional tours by Head teacher, SENCO and transition lead to support students likely to find transition trickier.
