Q1 – How convincing is interpretation A about... (8 marks)

- 2 paragraphs, use PEE, lots of facts!!
- P1 – Point, Evidence, Explain
- P2 – Point, Evidence, Explain + overall how convincing is the interpretation
- Only focus on the content – limited marks for provenance

Q2 – Explain what is important about...(8 marks)

- 2 PEEL paragraphs
- Must talk about 2 different aspects of the topic
- Try to link paragraphs

Q3 – Write an Account of...(8 marks)

- 2 PEEL paragraphs
- Try to write in chronological order

Q4 – “Statement about Drake’s Circumnavigation” How far does a study of Sheffield Manor support this statement? You should refer to Drake’s Circumnavigation and your contextual knowledge. (16 marks)

- X3 Extended PEEL paragraphs + conclusion
- P1 should be about the factor in the question
- P2 on another factor
- P3 on a final factor
- At least 3 pieces of specific evidence for each paragraph
- Must come to a judgement over which factor is the most important and why
- For top marks link factors together/have a sustained argument
