


Revision Advice for Media Studies 2025


Miss Fisher's Videos


Eduqas Blended Learning

Past Papers


- On the One Drive, there is a folder where I have collated all the past papers for Media Studies.

- Students can use these to practice questions, and study the mark schemes to know what to accomplish in each lesson






Senenca
