# GCSE French Exams Information 2025

- Exam board: AQA
- There are 4 exams, one in each skill: Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing
  - Each exam is worth 25% of the overall grade
- The Speaking exam will be first, scheduled for w/c 7<sup>th</sup> April (the week before Easter – details TBC)
  - Listening and Reading exams are on May 21<sup>st</sup>
    - The **Writing** exam is on 5<sup>th</sup> June
- There is a Foundation exam and a Higher exam you will do the same tier for all 4 exams. Tiers will be finalised after the final set of mocks.
  - Foundation covers grades 1-5, Higher covers grades 4-9
    - The topics covered are listed in the box to the right

## A menu of timings and tasks for your own revision

#### **Revision resources:**

- Cue cards
- Revision guides
- Online sources
- Past papers
- Booklets from school (ie speaking)
- Revision mindmaps
- Knowledge organisers
- VLE

#### 10-15 minute activities

- Complete an extended task on the VLE
- Go through a whole topic section on BBC Bitesize
- Record answers for oral exam questions to listen to them
- Plan a past paper role play and photo card
- Complete a translation and check it
- Find a text and practise reading / listening

#### 5 minute activities

- Quick online vocab test on the VLE
- Look cover check on vocab lists
- Make a quiz on a topic
- Write out key verbs for a tense from memory
- Plan a writing question what to write for each bullet point
- Rehearse out loud planned oral exam question answers

#### 30 minute activities

- a past paper for listening/reading
- planning answers to questions for the oral exam
- planning out 2 roles plays and 2 photo cards completing a writing task (2 (H) and 4 bullet point versions)
- Make a revision mind map for a topic or some grammar

## A one hour session could look like this....

#### **Explore an exam style question**

Take one or more bullet points from a writing task and plan out your paragraph to include at least 3-4 extended sentences and at least 1 opinion. (5 mins)

Make notes/lists, a revision clock or cue cards on a topic area or grammar point – divide your mindmap into 6 X 10 minute sections (15 mins)

#### Practice a question (30 mins)

Could be

- planning out 2 roles plays and 2 photo cards completing a writing task (2 (H) and 4 bullet point versions)
- 2 translations
